**GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND
REFERENDUM**

Shall the Town of Signal Mountain issue general obligation bonds in a maximum amount not to exceed 7.7 million dollars for the construction of a High School and Middle School building project to be located within the Town which shall be staffed and maintained by the Hamilton County School Board; provided that the debt service for these general obligation bonds will be payable based upon an ad valorem tax increase within the Town which shall not exceed .35 cents per 100 dollars of assessed property values which tax increase shall be eliminated after repayment of the bonded indebtedness for this construction project; and further provided that debt service payments on this bonded indebtedness may be supplemented by proceeds from the 1999 one-half cent sales tax or other revenues presently collected within the Town of Signal Mountain?
