Shall Ordinance No. 12566 to amend the Charter of the City of Chattanooga be approved so as to (1) establish an independent Office of Internal Audit, an Audit Committee, and City Auditor; (2) provide for the City Auditor's qualifications, appointment, and removal; and (3) provide for the Office's duties and access to records and property of the City?

ORDINANCE NO.. 12525

The Chattanooga City Council adopted Ordinance Number 12525 on July 12, 2011 on second reading which deannexed certain tax parcels which are located on and around Elder Mountain / Raccoon Mountain and certain portions of Elder Mountain Road and another roadway which are owned by city voters. Pursuant to T.C.A. 6-51-201 contraction of the limits of any territory annexed into a city shall not occur if opposed by a majority of the voters within this area.
