

Minutes
Hamilton County Election Commission
June 27, 2000

Upon call duly made and notice given Chairman Williams called the meeting to order with a quorum present. Commissioners Williams, Waller and Lane present. Commissioner Walden arrived late and Commissioner Cotter is on vacation.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Commissioner Lane, seconded by Commissioner Waller.

Old Business:

Early voting was discussed and Carolyn explained that we would be voting at Brainerd Village, in the same location as last April for the whole 15 days. There will be voting in Soddy Daisy at the fire hall for seven (7) days and then going to Northgate for seven (7) days.

There was discussion about the fire hall and the heat. The Commission authorized Carolyn to buy an air conditioner if necessary to help with the fire hall. Commissioner Waller made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Lane.

New Business:

Commissioner Lane made a motion to appoint the Election Day Officials (736), seconded by Commissioner Waller.

The Summit polling place was changed from the Silverdale Baptist Church to the Knights of Columbus building on Lee Highway. It is acceptable for the handicapped. Commissioner Lane made the motion to change the polling place, seconded by Commissioner Waller.

Mr. Jerry Summers, attorney discussed the Wolfe VS Thompson/Wheeler court case. Mr. Wolfe had a court hearing and the case was dismissed. He then appealed to the State Supreme court. As of this date Mr. Wolfe has not signed the order. The complaint was that he had gone to Nashville to file with the Division of Elections and failed to file a copy with the State Democratic Party Headquarters. Mr. Summers suggested that on the petition it should read "filing a petition to the Division of Elections does not excuse you from filing a copy of your petition with your party executive committee."

The Commissioners set the early voting hours at the satellites from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
