Hamilton County Election Commission
April 12, 2001

Upon call duly made and notice given Chairman Lane called the meeting to order with all members present except for Commissioner Cotter who was out.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved on a motion by Commission Johnson and seconded by Commissioner Walden.

The certification of expenses for the City of Chattanooga Runoff election of \$23,863.50 with the attorney fees to be assessed after the conclusion of litigation involving the municipal election, were approved on a motion by Commissioner Walden and seconded by Commissioner Johnson.

The certification of results were approved on a motion by Commissioner Walden and seconded by Commissioner Johnson.

Mr. Jerry Summers updated the Commission on the suit of Bibbins vs Election Commission. They will appear in court on Monday April 16, 2001. Mr. Summers sent a copy of a FAX from the plaintiff, which shows his efforts to supposedly comply with the State with specificity of the fraud allegations that form the basis of his complaint. Mr. Summers explained that there was one paragraph the Chancellor allowed him to leave in the litigation. With that result Mr. Summers filed a response to the motion to show cause and attached an affidavit from Administrator Jackson indicating our procedures and the fact that there were no complaints of any fraud allegation will be filed on Monday. A copy has been sent to Mr. Bibbins. Mr. Summers said that hopefully it will all be over on Monday.

There being no further business the meeting was duly and properly adjourned.
