

Minutes
Hamilton County Election Commission
April 23, 2001

Upon call duly made and notice given Chairman Lane called the meeting to order with all members present except for Commissioner Walden who was out of town.

The minutes of the previous meeting of April 12, 2001 were approved on a motion by Commissioner Waller and seconded by Commissioner Johnson.

Old Business:

Mr. Jerry Summers, attorney updated the Commission on the Bibbins vs Election Commission suit. On Monday April 16, 2001 they appeared in court. Administrator Jackson and Chairman Lane were there. Mr. Summer's explained that we are now out of the law suit. It will now be between Mr. Bibbins and Mr. Corker's counsel.

A copy of Mr. Summer's bill for his time spent on the City of Chattanooga municipal election will be sent to the city for payment.

Mr. Summer's explained to the Commission that they had 20 days after the Commissioners had their oaths to meet and select a Chairman and a Secretary. The date was set for May 7, 2001 at 5:00 p.m.

New Business:

The Early Voting dates suggested by Administrator Jackson were May 23rd through June 7th for the Red Bank and Soddy Daisy elections. The hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Red Bank and Soddy Daisy did not wish to have satellites. This was approved on a motion by Commissioner Waller and seconded by Commissioner Johnson.

The Commissioners were each given copies of the upcoming budget for 2001-2002. Administrator Jackson explained the budget and their time frame. After some discussion the meeting was duly and properly adjourned.
