CITY OF CHATTANOOGA MUNICIPAL

ORDINANCE NO. 12424 (Summary)

This amendment provides minor changes to Sections 3.79 and 13.49 of the Chattanooga City Charter and authorizes the Chattanooga City Council to establish administrative procedures by ordinance for City employees, including fire and police, to appeal certain disciplinary actions to an independent hearing body or judge instead of an appeal to a committee of the members of City Council as is currently provided in the Charter. This amendment does not alter or amend the rights of any City employees to appeal employment disciplinary actions currently recognized in the Chattanooga City Code or Chattanooga City Charter, but rather changes the process and procedures of employment disciplinary appeals. This amendment will result in little or no additional costs to the taxpayer since legal counsel for the City Council will be unnecessary under this amended procedure.

Certification of the Chief Financial Officer (Ordinance No. 12424 adopted August 17, 2010)

For Ordinance No. 12424: As a result of the change in administrative procedures, it is estimated that the costs to conduct employee disciplinary hearings will not exceed the current average cost of \$2,000.00 per employee.
