<p align="center">Constitutional Amendment 2</p> <p>Shall Article VI, Section 3 of the Constitution of Tennessee be amended by deleting the first and second sentences and by substituting instead the following:</p> <p>Judges of the Supreme Court or any intermediate appellate court shall be appointed for a full term or to fill a vacancy by and at the discretion of the governor; shall be confirmed by the Legislature; and thereafter, shall be elected in a retention election by the qualified voters of the state. Confirmation by default occurs if the Legislature fails to reject an appointee within sixty calendar days of either the date of appointment, if made during the annual legislative session, or the convening date of the next annual legislative session, if made out of session. Shall the proposed amendments to SECTION 5 of the Charter of the City of East Ridge, as specifically set forth in ORDINANCE NO. 974, with respect to certain grammatical and stylistic changes throughout those sections and with respect to the following specific changes: in SECTION 5, to add that elected officials are subject to recall as set forth in state law; in SECTION 5-A, to state that the Mayor and Councilmembers' salary and/or all other benefits may be adjusted only by referendum and not during their current term of office; in SECTION 5-D, to provide that all citizens are entitled to address the Council at all open meetings, unless restricted by majority vote of the Council; in SECTION 5-E, to provide that a Committee may be established to review the charter every five years; in SECTION 5-F, to amend the City Manager's education and experience requirements; in SECTION 5-G, to amend the City Manager's residency requirements; in SECTION 5-I, to update the City Manager's powers and duties; in SECTION 5-K, to provide that the City Manager may be removed only by a supermajority vote of the Council; and in SECTION 5-L, to state that the City Attorney can only be removed by a supermajority vote of the Council be approved?
