<b>City of Chattanooga Municipal</b>  <b>ORDINANCE NO. 13007</b> <b>(Summary)</b>  Shall Ordinance No. 13007 to amend the Home Rule Charter of the City of Chattanooga be approved so as to delete the language currently provided in Section 3.1.1 and replace it with the following:  "All employees of the City shall be residents of the State of Tennessee. This Section 3.1.1 shall only apply to those employees working in general government of the City. Those employees who were hired on or before January 18, 1990, and who have lived outside the State of Tennessee continuously since said date, shall be exempted from this Section 3.1.1?"  <u><b>CERTIFICATION OF THE CHIEF FINANCE OFFICER</b></u>  The proposed amendment shall not have a material impact upon the City's finances.
